Healthcare professionals who want to learn decision making skills in both medical crisis and everyday emergency situations.

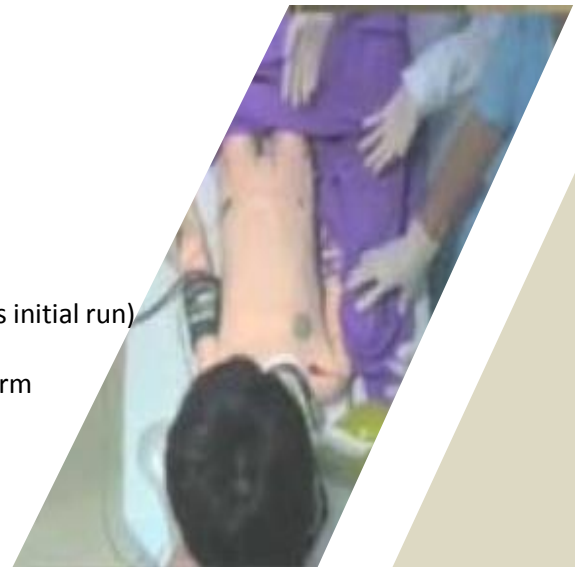
Training Format:
