Ancient methods of dealing with bone and joint injuries are unsurpassed even today in their accuracy and clinical application. The treatment for dislocations of the shoulder and hip joints has not been bettered since. The advancement of modern orthopaedics not only saves innumerable lives of warriors in battle fields and victims of accidents, but also helps to improve the quality of life and to prolong the life span of those facing daily with musculoskeletal problems.
